I also heard complaints by voters who had no idea that their polling place changed and getting angry with us.

Perhaps you should send out alerts to have voters check online for changes prior to heading to polling place.

Separately, my media communications expertise, combined with my firsthand experience working in the trenches with voters , would be a valuable asset to you and your team to improve election communications.
