

My concern is that poll workers in Brooklyn were bypassed for Early Voting assignments UNLESS they served on campaign committees favored by the Kings County Democratic Party leadership. As a reform candidate, I was refused Early Voting work assignments despite many years of service as a poll worker and a coordinator, as well as positive evaluations by supervisory staff in the past. When I visited my Early Voting site, many of those with whom I worked were employed, as well as many new workers. The board's hiring process should be based on merit, not blatant self-interest by the Democratic Party's incumbent leadership.
